This 4101 High Ridge Project will consist of 47 HP 12x53 steel piles for an approximate total of 1880 LF. The proposed culvert is an 12' x 4' Precast R.C Box Culvert for 45 LF. The endwalls will be Non-Standard Endwalls. There is also a pump around operation, relocation of a 12" DI Restrained Joint Water Pipe, PC 350 for 52 LF, Concrete Culvert Foundation, and Traffic Control for Road Closure is needed to complete this project.
