The Vendor(s) would be responsible for supplying all parts, labor, and towing from the CATS location, travel to the vendor's site, the performance of the body repairs, and return to the CATS location in full operating condition. Work shall be performed by a certified bus rebuild contractor of established reputation with a minimum of five (5) years experience performing major repair on Transit Buses. All repair work shall be completed in order to meet all Federal Motor Vehicle Safety Standards (FMVSS). PSR 1221
