Fire Station #41 Expansion

This project involves the construction of an expansion to the existing Aircraft Rescue and Fire Fighting (ARFF) Station No. 41. The 6400 square foot expansion will include four bays added to the existing structure and associated mechanical, electrical and plumbing (MEP). The project also consists of the relocation of an existing 50'x60' sprung structure and up to 12,662 square feet of concrete pavement around the fire station. Note: The base bid for concrete paving is 7217sf. The 12,662sf is part of an alternate bid.
