West Mallard Creek Church Road Shared- Use Path

This project is being built to add sidewalks as part of the city's Capital Investment Fund to provide a safe, efficient, comfortable pedestrian system to improve the quality of life of its residents, visitors, and businesses. Improvements will be provided along the south side of West Mallard Creek Church Road, from Mallard Creek Road to roughly 600' east of Claude Freeman Drive. The project proposes a 12 ft. shared-use path, a typical 8 ft. planting strip (where possible), signalization and intersection improvements at David Taylor Drive, and intersection improvements at Claude Freeman Drive.

Requirements

Insurance Requirements

The City requires the awarded vendor(s) to obtain and maintain the following insurance coverage types:

Bid Bond-City required Bond to ensure that vendors do not retract bids from the time they submit a bit until the contract has been executed.

Payment Bond-City required Bond to ensure that subcontractors and/or suppliers are paid for any work performed.

Performance Bond-City required Bond to ensure satisfactory completion of a project by the vendor.
