Workers Compensation Medical Services-CANCELED

The City of Charlotte's Risk Management Division is seeking proposals from qualified Companies to provide medical services for employees of Charlotte-Mecklenburg Schools, Charlotte Regional Visitors Authority, and/or Mecklenburg EMS Agency (CRVA) who are injured on the job. Combined, these five (5) organizations employ approximately 37,500 individuals. All workers compensation claims are processed through a third-party administrator. The Company is expected to work with the third-party administrator to ensure the claims are processed in a satisfactory and timely manner. The Company shall act as the representative for the Employer related to such services, including but not limited to the following:

Provide medical services pursuant to this contract for the Employing Agencies and their employees as a liaison to the medical providers.
Provide a minimum of three (3) locations within Mecklenburg County with seven (7) day a week access to medical services for the Employing Agency for treatment of on-the-job injuries. Every location must provide the same level of service as the primary location.
Medical Doctors on staff who specialize in Occupational Medicine and are able to meet the medical needs of the injured employees.

- Provide an initial prescription card if injured employees require a prescription; and
- Work with Employing Agencies to ensure proper exposure-related claims.
- Possible addendum for CRVA
