Workers Compensation Medical Services-CANCELED

The City of Charlotte's Risk Management Division is seeking proposals from qualified Companies to provide medical services for employees of Charlotte-Mecklenburg Schools, Charlotte Regional Visitors Authority, and/or Mecklenburg EMS Agency (CRVA) who are injured on the job. Combined, these five (5) organizations employ approximately 37,500 individuals. All workers compensation claims are processed through a third-party administrator. The Company is expected to work with the third-party administrator to ensure the claims are processed in a satisfactory and timely manner. The Company shall act as the representative for the Employer related to such services, including but not limited to the following:

Provide medical services pursuant to this contract for the Employing Agencies and their employees as a liaison to the third-party administrator. Provide a minimum of three (3) locations within Mecklenburg County with seven (7) day a week access to medical services for the Employing Agency for treatment of on-the-job injuries. Every location must provide the same level of service as the third-party administrator. Medical Doctors on staff who specialize in Occupational Medicine and are able to meet the medical needs of the injured employees.

- Provide an initial prescription card if injured employees require a prescription; and
- Work with Employing Agencies to ensure proper exposure-related claims.
